
Online Writing Center and Reading and Writing Lab



College of Marin offers online and on-campus tutoring for reading and writing in any subject in the Reading and Writing Lab (RWL) and the Online Writing Center (OWC). Students can get help from COM English instructors and professional tutors with:

- Understanding assignments and readings
- Writing assignments for all college subjects
- Brainstorming, essay and paragraph organization, idea development, research, and grammar
- College entrance essays, UC/CSU applications
- Scholarship applications
- Resumes and cover letters

You can choose one of three ways of working with a tutor (or try all three!):

- RWL Drop in to work with an English instructor or tutor No appointment necessary!
 - Kentfield Campus, Bldg. PV4: M-W: 8am-5pm; TH: 8am-6pm; F: 11am-2pm
 - o Indian Valley Campus, Building 7, Room 103: Thursday 12:15 − 1:15pm
- RWL Zoom appointment with a tutor or English instructor, at various times
- Online Writing Center submit your work and receive a written response from a tutor

Follow these instructions to access the RWL/OWC in Canvas:

- 1. Click on the Fall 2023 RWL/OWC Canvas page link or follow the instructions below:
- 2. Log into Canvas from the MyCOM portal.
- 3. Click the Student Support icon on the main navigation menu OR click on the **COM Online Tutoring/Labs** link in the course navigation bar in the left-hand column within your course.
- 4. Click the **Reading/Writing Lab & OWC** link.
- 5. Click the **Enroll in course** button. You now have the RWL/OWC Canvas course on your dashboard. Guidelines and instructions for accessing tutoring are on this page. For your convenience, the instructions are also listed below.

To schedule a Zoom RWL appointment:

- 1. On the Canvas RWL/OWC page (or on your MyCOM portal), click on the "RWL Appointments" button.
- 2. Click on "Make Appointment." Select the date/times that work for you and click on "Find Appointments."
- 3. Select a day and time for your appointment.
- 4. On the next page, confirm your e-mail address. Click "Continue."
- 5. Once scheduled, you and the instructor will receive a confirmation email with a Zoom link.
- 6. At the time of the appointment, join the online meeting via the Zoom link.
- 7. The instructor may ask you to share your screen with your draft or e-mail your draft.
- 8. Please cancel the appointment if you are unable to attend. You can cancel on the first "RWL Appointments" page (see step 1).

To request tutoring assistance on the Online Writing Center:

The OWC is open 24/7 to help students with writing assignments for all subjects. Submit your rough draft and receive feedback from a tutor within 36 hours.

- 1. On the Canvas RWL/OWC page, click on "OWC Tutoring Request."
- 2. Review the OWC Tutoring Student Guidelines.
- 3. Click on **Submit OWC Tutoring Request**. You will be directed to complete a form on the COM website (You may be required to re-enter your MyCOM login information.)
- 4. If submitting a file, upload a Word document at the end of the form. Click on "Upload" and "Submit."
- 5. You will receive an email confirmation of your submission to the OWC service desk. The confirmation will go to your **MyCOM email** and it will be from the **Service Desk.**

Viewing your feedback from your tutor:

- 1. You can find your feedback by logging in to the Service Desk. To do this:
 - a. Log into MyCOM,
 - b. Click on "Service Desk."
 - c. Click on "Submit a Ticket." You will be able to view any tickets you have submitted.
- 2. In addition, an email from the tutor will be sent to your MyCOM email address (NOT your Canvas mail). You can reply to the tutor directly from your MyCOM email.
- 3. The tutor will close the ticket once he/she has responded to your request; if you have another question, please submit a new request.

<u>Troubleshooting</u>: If you do not receive an e-mail with your OWC feedback within 36 hours, you can find your feedback by logging in to the Service Desk (see #2 in the instructions above).
