ADMISSIONS PROCESS

- Applicants submit
 - Free online application
 - Transcripts from all colleges/universities attended since high school
- Two-week review and response
- Minimum 40 transferable credits (IGETC, CSU, UC or ADT)
- Minimum 2.0 GPA
