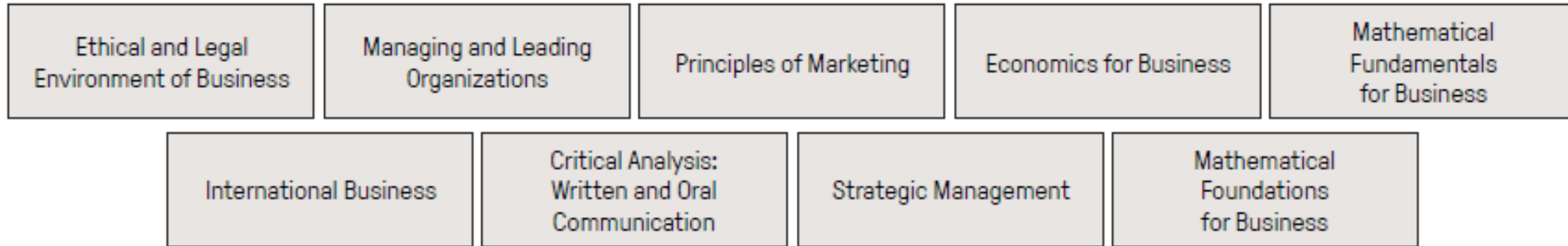

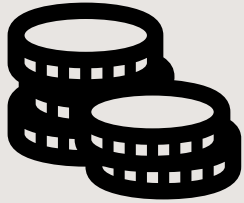

# PARTNERSHIP PROGRAM HIGHLIGHTS



## Affordable

- 30% tuition discount
- Active military service members, spouses, reservists and national guardsmen receive a 70% tuition discount



## Flexible & Convenient

- Courses are offered both in-person and synchronously online
- Courses are delivered one at a time over an 8-week accelerated term and meet one evening per week



## Accelerated Pathway to Degree Completion

- An Associate's degree is not a prerequisite for admission, allowing students to start their business major coursework at Redlands sooner
- Program can be completed in as little as 22 months

# ADMISSIONS PROCESS

- Applicants submit
  - Free online application
  - Transcripts from all colleges/universities attended since high school
- Two-week review and response
- Minimum 40 transferable credits (IGETC, CSU, UC or ADT)
- Minimum 2.0 GPA
