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Other information:

Common requirements to fulfill **after** provisional admission are: the TEAS (Test of Essential Academic Skills) exam with a score of 62% or higher, drug screen, criminal background check, immunization records, TB test, physical exam, CPR certification, Basic Life Support Certificate. Failure to follow requirements after provisional admission will result in loss of admission to program. Follow up diligently! It is the student's responsibility to ensure all contact information is current and accurate. If there are any changes, contact the program to update them.

Students applying to a community college RN program must also apply to the community college itself. Do not forget this important step in the application process.

All RN programs require a score of 62% or above on the TEAS (Test of Essential Academic Skill). There is a TEAS study book in the reference section of the library as well as in the Transfer and Career Center to help you.

Beware the Recency Requirement! If a school does not have a recency requirement, a repeated course will usually count against a student on their application score. However, if the course was taken many years previously, you may need to repeat it in order to be eligible for schools that do have a recency requirement. Repeat courses with caution. Meet with a counselor for more guidance on this matter and to know how best to strategize when applying to multiple schools with varying requirements.

Most schools offer an information session. If you are serious about applying, you will attend.
