Typically admit 60 students per semester. Average GPA of admitted students: 3.52 or higher					
<b>CSU Sacramento</b> Fall and Spring Admits	Minimum GPA of 3.3  TEAS score of 75%; scores must be submitted with supplemental application  Typically admit 80 per semester. <b>Dominican University</b> Fall and Spring Admits	All applicants admitted to Pre-Nursing major, no guarantee to get into Nursing program. Once in Pre-Nursing, must go through application review process.  Pre-Nursing students apply to nursing program late January to early February for the following academic year.
